Can you run a race and be the winner?"



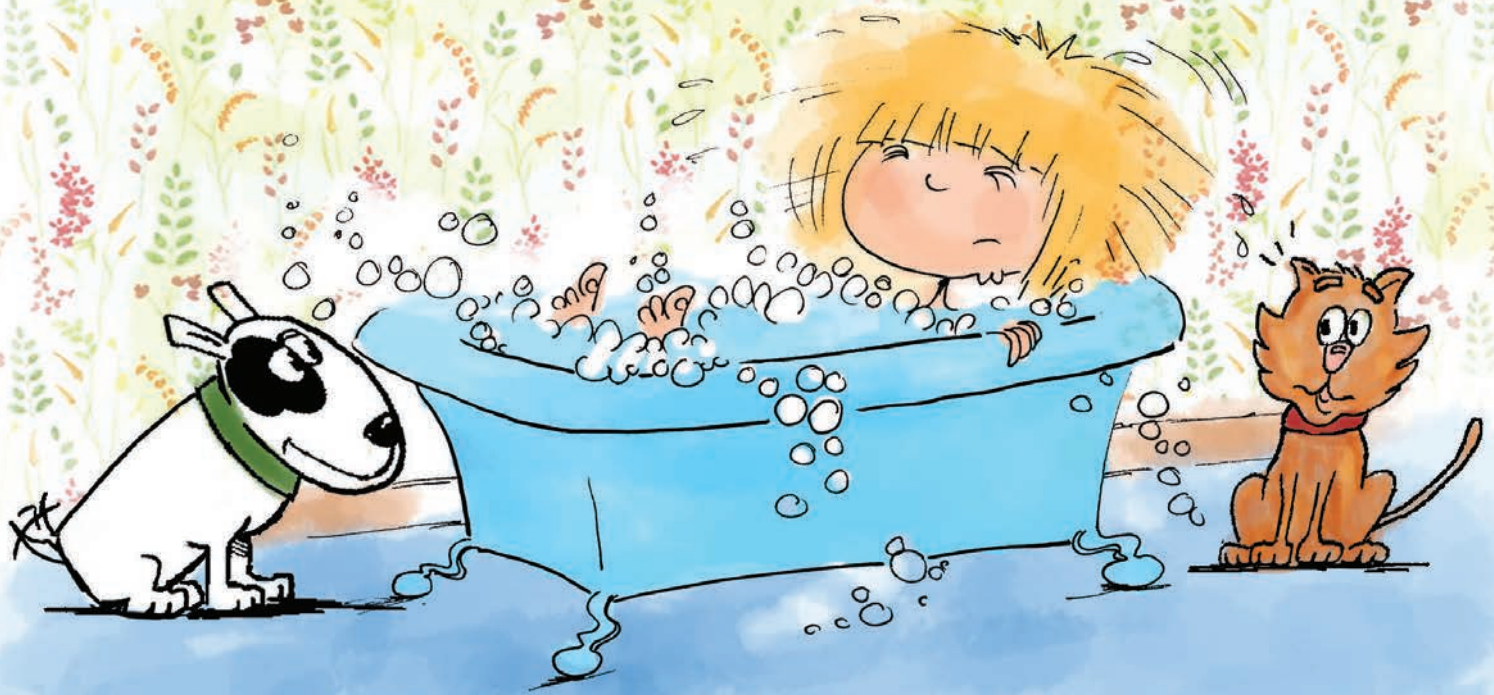
“Do you want to stay in the bath and dance?
